

NB 38th Annual Math Competition

Report: February 4, 2024

The 2023 Math Competition, held on May 13th after a pause since 2019, saw a triumphant return, hosted across the University of New Brunswick at Fredericton and Saint John, along with l'Université de Moncton at their Moncton, Edmundston, and Shippagan campuses. The competition was conducted in both English and French, welcoming **1,085 students** from grades 7 to 9, with participants from all 7 school districts demonstrating its widespread appeal.

We extend our gratitude to the NB Department of Education and Early Childhood Development, AARMS, CMS and the host universities for their support. This year, due to a technical issue, awards were mailed to winners, including mathematically themed T-shirts, diplomas, books or magazine subscriptions for district winners, pewter medals for the top students in each grade, and monetary prizes for the top performers at each campus.

A heartfelt thank you to everyone involved in the 2023 Math Competition. The combined efforts of faculty, staff, students, and volunteers from all participating campuses were crucial.
